Two enormous Nio statues have been waiting for your visit for 700 years since the Kamakura Period (1185-1333).

The temple has a beautiful large garden surrounded by three forested hills. Experience a trip to Mikko Jodo, or the Pure Land (the Buddhist paradise reigned by the Bodhisattva Maitreya) through two red wooden bridges.
