Guided Tour Fee

The minimum fee is 2,500 yen for a guest to 5 guests.

For more than 6 people, 500 yen per person is added on 2,500 yen.

(e.g. For 7 people :2,500yen + (500yen x 2 =1,000yen) = 3,500 yen in total.)
