

Tsurushi Hina-Dolls Festival



There is a traditional Japanese event called "Girl's Festival" to pray for the happiness of girls. Among them, "Tsurushi Hina" is a small doll and decoration hung from red strings using scraps of fabric, and is said to have started in the Edo period. Each one is filled with the warm wishes of parents for their children. We will visit the places in Kanazawa where "Tsurushi Hina" are displayed. At the end, you will have the opportunity to experience "Origami" (paper folding) with your wish in mind (optional).
